# Membership report



- 442 new membership agreements received since JCP 2.10 was introduced in May 2016.
  - 333 Associate Membership Agreements (27 were converted from individual full memberships).
  - 25 Partner Membership Agreements (5 were converted from JUG full memberships).
  - 31 Employer Contribution Agreements.
  - 27 individual JSPAs.
  - 25 corporate JSPAs.
  - 1 non-profit JSPA.

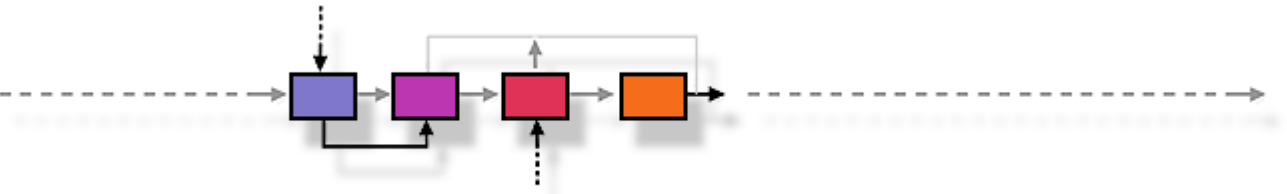
