

- 2020 JCP EC Election nominations open until 5 October; Meet The Candidates call is 29 October

- JCP EC now has 20 Members
- For the 2020 annual elections, one Ratified and one Elected Seats will be eliminated, thereby reducing the EC to 18 members, per JCP section 2.11.10

EC Membership Best Practices

- Review & comment on Specifications -substantial/staff experts
- Contribute to projects (OpenJDK or other) & TCK development
- Test EA builds regularly and provide timely bug reports/comments on discussions
- Value of adopting new versions of Java promote
- New versions of Java & standalone JSRs share news & adoption
- Promote awareness of new early access builds and testing
- Share experiences with it and migration best practices





Membership Report

- 889 new membership agreements received since JCP 2.10 was introduced in May 2016.
- 670 Associate Membership Agreements (52 were converted from individual full memberships).
- 56 Partner Membership Agreements (5 were converted from JUG full memberships).
- 62 Employer Contribution Agreements.
- 58 individual JSPAs.
- 41 corporate JSPAs.
- 2 non-profit JSPAs.


